Notice is hereby given pursuant to <u>Code of Alabama</u>, 1975, Section 9-15-70 et seq. that **sealed bids** for the sale of state property located in Baldwin County, Alabama will be received **until MARCH 11**, **2025**, **4:00 P.M.**, as detailed below, by the office of the State Lands Division, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. Pursuant to the above referenced Code Section, Officers and employees of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and the Department of Agriculture and Industries, as well as members of their families, shall be excluded from bidding on any tract(s) described herein.

A parcel of land in Baldwin County, Alabama, being more commonly known as the FARMER'S MARKET AUTHORITY PARCEL 21, which is more particularly described as follows:

A tract of land with improvements located at 18240 County Road 28, Summerdale, Alabama in Township 7 South, Range 4 East, Section 7, identified by Parcel ID: 54-03-07-0-000-004.004, containing approximately 5.2 acres with a +/- 1,650 square feet warehouse building and +/- 8,100 square foot canopy.

Any conveyance will be made subject to:

The successful bidder's deposit will be applied to the purchase price.

NO BID SHALL BE RECEIVED FOR ANY REASON ANY TIME AFTER MARCH 11, 2025, 4:00 P.M. IT SHALL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE BIDDER TO ENSURE ACTUAL RECEIPT OF THE BID BY THE STATE LANDS DIVISION PRIOR TO THIS DEADLINE. All bids received by this deadline will be publicly opened and read on the following day, March 12, 2025, 2:00 P.M. in the office of the State Lands Division. If ADA accommodations are needed as to the bid opening, please contact Delicia Baker at (334) 242-3484. Requests should be made as soon as possible but at least seven days prior to the bid opening date.

The successful bidder shall reimburse the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries for the cost of the appraisal in the amount of \$2,200 and for the advertisement fees incurred for this notice.

Specification of a minimum bid amount to be considered does not suggest acceptance of any bid which may equal or exceed that amount. The State does not warrant nor guarantee title to the lands herein advertised or otherwise warrant or guarantee the condition of the land or any improvements.

This sale is conducted pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Land Sales and Leasing Act (Act 95-280) and/or other laws of the State of Alabama governing this transaction whether or not included in this notice.

The State reserves the right to reject any or all bids and further reserves the right to negotiate a higher sale price amount with the highest bidder. In the event a successful bidder fails to complete the transaction, the State further reserves the right to negotiate with the next highest qualifying bidder.

The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, age, sex, national origin, disability, pregnancy, genetic information or veteran status in its hiring or employment practices nor in admission to, access to, or operations of its programs, services, or activities.
