From Montgomery:

Take I-65 North. Merge onto AL-152 E / Northern Blvd. via exit 173 toward US- 231 for 6.3 miles. Turn left onto US-231 N / AL-21 N for 10.9 miles. Turn left onto AL-14 / Coosa River Pkwy for 1.5 miles. Turn Right onto AL-111 / Holtville Rd. for 4.7 miles the hunting area will be on the right/E side, look for the Entrance Sign. **SHOTGUN ONLY**

From Auburn:

Take I-85 S. take exit 26, AL 229 N (Ev Smith exit) toward Tallassee for 7.7 miles to AL-14 W. Stay on AL-14 W for 21 miles to AL-111. Turn Right onto AL-111 / Holtville Rd. for 4.7 miles the hunting area will be on the right/E side, look for the Entrance Sign. **SHOTGUN ONLY**

Season is Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays from November 18th to February 10th. Bag limit is (1) deer per day and **three (3) deer per season**. All antlered bucks harvested must be included as part of the annual statewide three (3) buck limit. No archery hunting; the shooting houses are designated for gun hunters only. **SHOTGUN ONLY**
