

PRAIRIE CREEK

PHYSICALLY DISABLED HUNTING AREA



FROM MONTGOMERY:

Take U.S. Highway 80 West approximately 30 miles (look for U.S. Army Corps-Prairie Creek/Holy Ground Access Sign) and turn right onto Lowndes County Road 23. Travel on County Road 23 for 4.5 miles until you come to a stop sign at White Hall. Turn left at stop sign on Lowndes County Road 40. Drive approximately 3.5 miles and look for Prairie Creek entrance sign on right. Turn right on Prairie Creek entrance road and follow signs to check-in station on the left.

FROM SELMA:

Follow U.S. Highway 80 East approximately 20 miles (look for U.S. Army Corps-Prairie Creek/Holy Ground Access Sign) and turn left on Lowndes County Road 23. Travel on County Road 23 approximately 4.5 miles until you come to a stop sign at White Hall. Turn left at stop sign on Lowndes County Road 40. Drive approximately 3.5 miles and look for Prairie Creek entrance sign on right. Turn right at Prairie Creek entrance road and follow signs to check-in station on the left.

Season is Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays from October 15 to February 10. Bag limit is one (1) deer per day (either sex) and three (3) deer per season. All antlered bucks harvested must be included as part of the annual statewide three (3) antlered buck limit.
