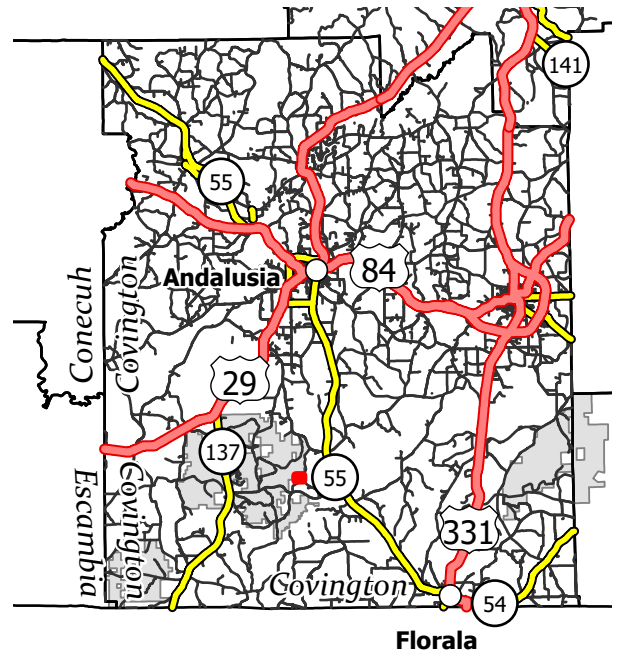
ALL HUNTING MUST BE DONE FROM THE SHOOTING HOUSE. ALL HUNTERS MUST SIGN IN PRIOR TO HUNTING. AFTER HUNTING, SIGN OUT AND RECORD ALL HARVEST AND WILDLIFE OBSERVATION DATA ON THE SIGN IN/OUT SHEET LOCATED AT THE KIOSK.

FROM ANDALUSIA:
 Take State Highway 55 South for about 12 miles to Red Oak. Turn right (west) on County Road 31 and go about 1 mile. Turn left (south) on Shiloh Road and go about 2 miles. The area will be on the right (west) side of the road.

FROM FLORALA:
 Take State Highway 55 North for about 8.5 miles. Turn left (west) on County Road 24 and go about 1.5 miles. Turn right (north) on Shiloh Road and go about 2 miles. The area will be on the left (west) side of the road.

Season is Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from Nov 1 to Feb 10. Bag limit is one (1) deer (either sex) and **THREE (3) DEER PER SEASON**. All antlered bucks harvested must be included as part of the annual statewide three (3) buck limit. Archery only from Nov 1 to Nov 18. While shooting houses are not designed for archery hunting, especially with a long bow, this opportunity is being provided for those that desire to use crossbows or other archery equipment.
