To All Potential Respondents: This Addendum is issued to modify the previously issued RFQ documents and/or is provided for informational purposes, and is hereby made a part of the RFQ documents.

RFI 8) Would the selected firm be disqualified from providing engineering and design, permitting and construction management services for DWH-funded projects executed by ADCNR subrecipients, such as the City of Mobile, City of Gulf Shores and/or Mobile County?

Answer: In basic terms, the firm(s) selected under this RFQ cannot undertake the dual of role of Program Management on behalf of ADCNR and oversight of the firm's own engineering and design, permitting, construction oversight or construction work for subrecipients utilizing DWH funds now or in the future.

RFI 9) Our understanding is that all GEBF funds have been awarded and most of the project have been completed. Will there be work related to NFWF GEBF?

Answer: In relation to the entire portfolio of Alabama's DWH projects, the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation-Gulf Environmental Benefit Fund (GEBF) projects represent a small portion of the total work. Alabama's NFWF-GEBF funds have been largely awarded at this time. There could be a relatively small amount of work related to ongoing management and monitoring of those existing projects but significant "new" NFWF-GEBF projects are not anticipated.
